Student learning and development are our top priorities! Instruction is provided to students by partner teachers. One teacher focuses on Math/Science while the partner focuses on LA/Social Studies. Students participate in one elective class.

Student daily performance, assessments and test results are used to plan instruction. Together with teachers, students use their own data to set SMART Goals to take ownership and be responsible for their own learning achievements.

We believe it is essential for each child to believe they are capable of learning anything. Lindsey Steiner focuses on these beliefs through Capturing Kids' Hearts and encouraging a Growth Mind Set in our students. We often use the word "Yet" after a child has proclaimed he/she can't do a task. (I can't do math...yet.) In addition, posters are hung throughout the building providing students with alternative strategies to help them believe in themselves.
